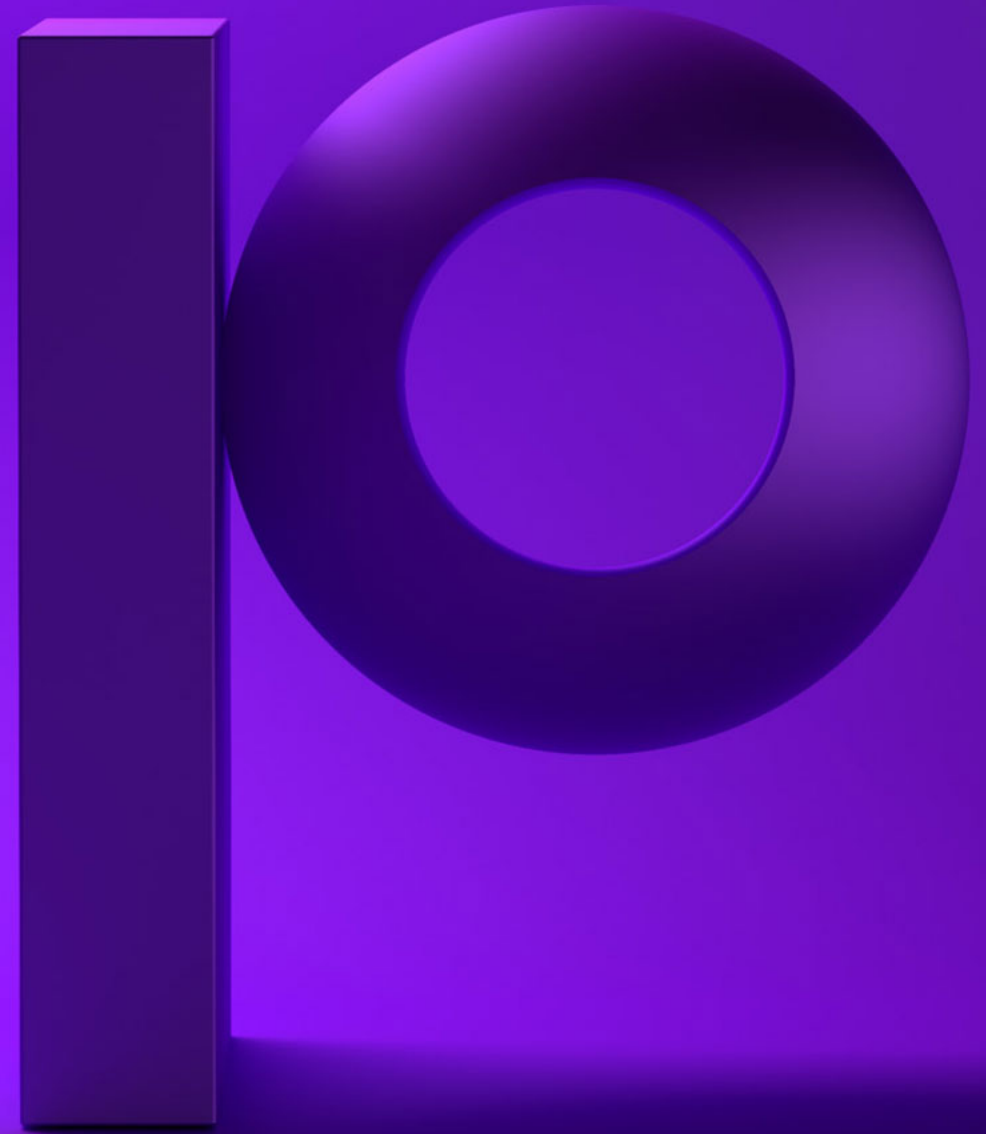

## Urban planning



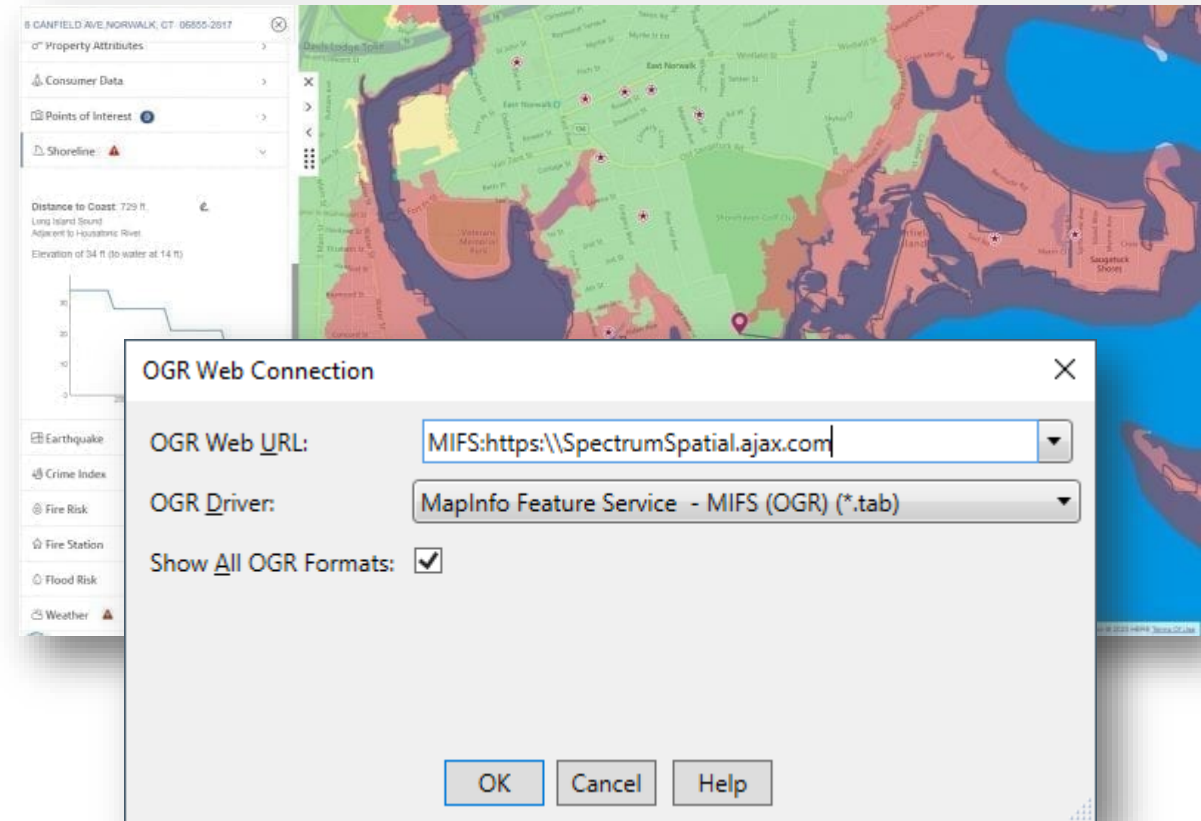
